IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS

NW Natural's customers can receive help making their homes and businesses more energy efficient through Energy Trust of Oregon. Energy Trust offers cash incentives and other services designed to help you save energy and money.

The Oregon Public Utility Commission (OPUC) has established rules about how and what customer information NW Natural and Energy Trust must share.

What information do we share?

NW Natural must provide customer name, service address, historical gas usage, energy-efficiency program participation information, building type, heat type and rate type. Energy Trust is required by law to hold this information in strict confidence. NW Natural does not provide information such as social security numbers, drivers' license numbers, or any financial information. Energy Trust must provide NW Natural with information about the energy-efficiency measures our customers install through participation in their programs.

How is this information used?

Energy Trust will use the information to help design, evaluate and improve the energy-efficiency programs they offer to our customers and may also use the information to contact you directly about their programs.

NW Natural will use the information to update equipment information on your account and capture changes in gas usage that result from customer efforts to save energy. Usage data helps us in setting rates, as well as other types of financial analysis.

Do-not-contact option:
