

We are excited to see more people than ever notifying 8-1-1 before they dig. This simple step helps prevent safety hazards and service interruptions. Customers in Washington use this free service to locate underground utility lines before installing a fence, building a deck, planting trees and completing other home improvements.

If you haven't used 8-1-1 before, just call or submit a request online. Within a couple of days, a technician will mark the underground utility lines that deliver essential services to your home—like natural gas, electricity, water, sewer and cable—so you know exactly where it's safe to dig.


Want to save more with your current gas furnace?
