Re: UG-260661 Schedule 240 – NW Natural Peak Flex Partners Program for Large Commercial and Industrial Customers – Replacement Tariff Sheets – DO NOT REDOCKET

On August 7, 2026, Northwest Natural Gas Company, dba NW Natural (“NW Natural” or “Company”), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (“Commission”) Advice No. 26-07, docketed at UG-260661, to propose new Schedule 240 related to its geographically target behavioral demand response program, branded as NW Natural Peak Flex Partners, with a requested effective date of October 1, 2026.

After discussion with Commission Staff, NW Natural submits this filing replacing tariff sheets 240.1 and 240.2 to:

1. Change the requested effective date from October 1, 2026 to October 9, 2026.
2. Correct the title of tariff Sheet 240.2 to match Sheet 240.1
3. Add language to Sheet 240.1 to clarify NW Natural will cover the cost and installation of an AAMR meter up to \$4,575.

NW NATURAL PEAK FLEX PARTNERS

PURPOSE:

To describe and set forth the terms and conditions for NW Natural's geographically targeted behavioral demand response program, branded as the NW Natural Peak Flex Partners program (Peak Flex Partners). This program will be provided to customers in geographically targeted zip codes.

APPLICABLE:

To all Large Commercial and Industrial Firm Sales customers served under the following Rate Schedules and reside in the geographically targeted zip codes in NW Natural's service territory in Washington:

Rate Schedule 41	Rate Schedule 42	Rate Schedule 43
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BEHAVIORAL DEMAND RESPONSE PROGRAMS:

Eligible Firm Sales Large Commercial and Industrial Customers will earn incentives for reducing their natural gas use during Demand Response Events. Incentives are earned based on the verified therm reduction during the Demand Response Events. Customers may reduce their usage in a variety of ways, such as space heating, water heating, process heating, and operational shifts, if plausible.

Demand Response Events may be called on days when low temperatures are forecasted to be 32°F or below or the daily average temperature is forecasted at 34°F or below or at other critical times such as the distribution system has an emergency.

The Peak Flex Partners season will be November 1 through March 31, with the demand response event window from 7:00 AM through 11:00 AM. Demand Response Events may last up to four hours.

CONDITIONS:

1. Must be a NW Natural firm sales Large Commercial or Industrial customer located in geographically targeted zip codes. Customers on an interruptible rate schedule may not participate in this program.
2. Customer first must complete and sign an enrollment agreement.
3. Enrolled customers must have a functioning hourly gas metering equipment installed during the Peak Flex Partners program season (November 1 through March 31). Participants without existing and functioning hourly gas metering equipment will be required to install an interval data metering device which will be provided and installed at a cost up to \$4,575.

PROGRAM DESIGN:

The Peak Flex Partners program season will run from November 1 through March 31. A Demand Response Event will generally last for no more than four hours between 7:00 AM and 11:00 AM. An email notification to customers will be given 24-hour notice or more of a Demand Response Event and additional notice 15 minutes before the Demand Response Event starts.
